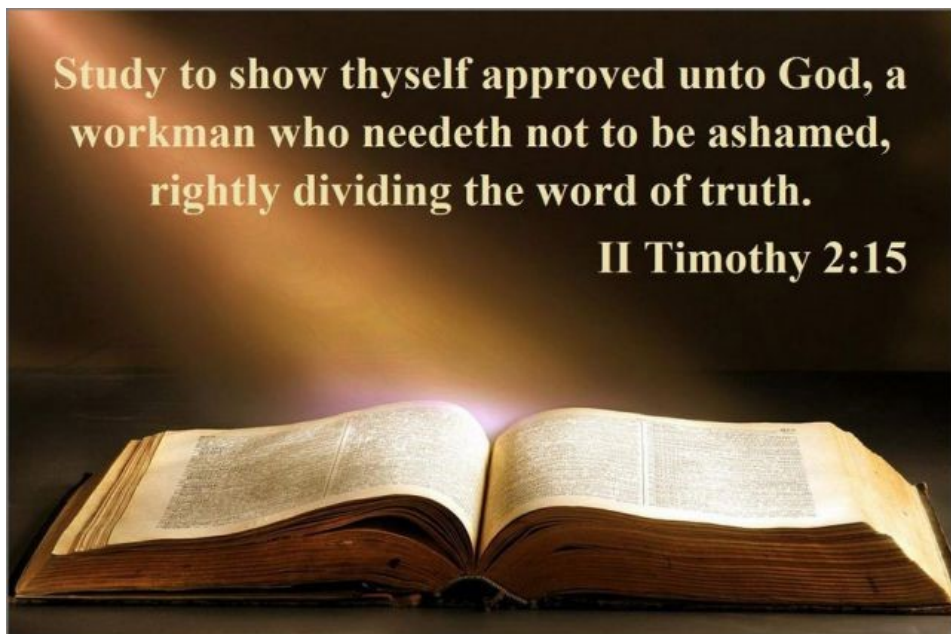

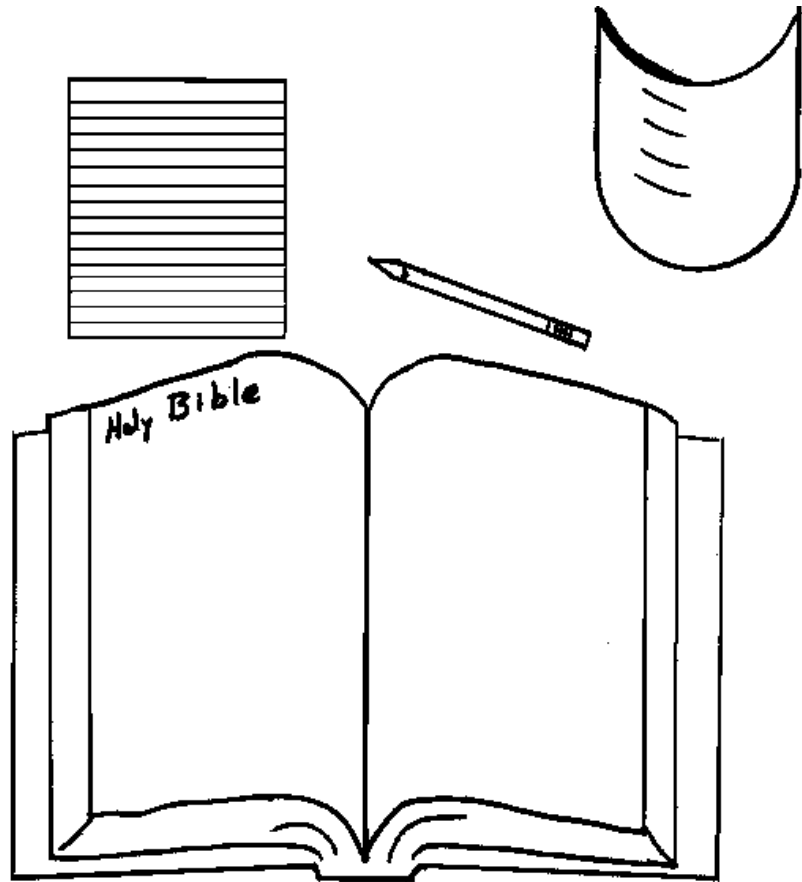
This month Pastor Jeff is preaching on “**Sermons on the Authority of Scripture**”. His topic today is “**Study is Required**”.





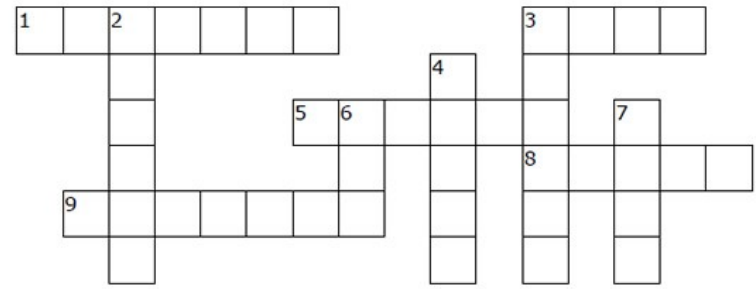
